Working document on Draft input from the alignment process to the Ad Hoc Working Group on GA revitalization

Consideration of general principles:

- 1. **Stresses** that United Nations intergovernmental bodies need to effectively address the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development in its entirety, including its 17 Sustainable Development Goals, in order to effectively and efficiently support its accelerated implementation during the Decade of Action.
- 2. **Notes** that it is necessary to further align the agendas of the General Assembly, the Economic and Social Council and its functional commissions and expert bodies with the 2030 Agenda, considering a comprehensive and holistic view of the agendas, and **also notes** that the General Assembly process on alignment needs to identify and address gaps, overlaps and duplications in a balanced manner and on a case by case basis, taking into account the respective mandates and distinct functions of each
