- 2". The Organization a\$(no' ledges the importan\$e of ta(ing lea%e and %isiting family during these times. -taff mem&ers may ta(e ad%antage of home lea%e# family %isit or edu\$ation grant tra%el if eligi&le# ta(ing into \$onsideration tra%el ad%isories at departure# arri%al and transit points.
- +2. -taff mem&ers may tele\$ommute or ' or (remotely ' hen tra%elling on home lea%e#family %isit or edu\$ation grant tra%el. *o' e%er#they ' ill &e re=uired to ta(e at least fi%e 576 days of annual lea%e during the period of tra%el. Tele\$ommuting or remote ' or (may &e parti\$ularly appropriate and en\$ouraged ' hen staff mem&ers are re=uired to =uarantine.

Considering possi&le tra%el restri\$tions to the \$ountry of home lea%e# staff mem&ers may re=uest and &e authorized to tra%el to a \$ountry other than the \$ountry of home lea%e in a\$\$ordan\$e' ith se\$tion : .1 of -T01l02217020. e%.1 on *ome lea%e. The amount of tra%el and transportation expenses &orne &y the Organization shall not ex\$eed the \$ost of tra%el to the pla\$e of home lea%e.
