

Melbourne Water is a statutory authority owned by the Government of the State of Victoria, Australia. Melbourne Water is responsible for all water supply and wastewater treatment iginates from

the Yarra River catchment, an area of more than 4,000 km² located to the North and East of Melbourne.

The operation of the eleven mini-hydro plants allows Melbourne Water supply operations to contribute more electricity to the grid than is needed for the operation of the water supply facilities.

All mini hydro plants are fully remote-controlled, operational from offsite, and seamlessly

produce renewable electricity from sustainable sources.


