Current and past success stories that supported our progress such Crop and livestock intensification, One cow per poor family, small livestock promotion, Kichen gardens, Early Childhood Development Centres at village level, National Strategic Food Reserves will be scaled up.

In keeping with continental coalitions effort such as *African Common Position in Food Systems Transformation*, Rwanda is strongly committed to join other leaders of the United Nations, civil society, academia and the private sector to scale up school meals programmes to combat child hunger and reach healthy and nutritious meal in schools by 2030.

In conclusion, Rwanda does recognize multifaceted nature of the Food Systems. Therefore, delivering on the promise of a well-functioning food system requires a concerted effort nationally, regionally, and internationally between stakeholders to show a united front in tackling the numerous food system challenges and to
