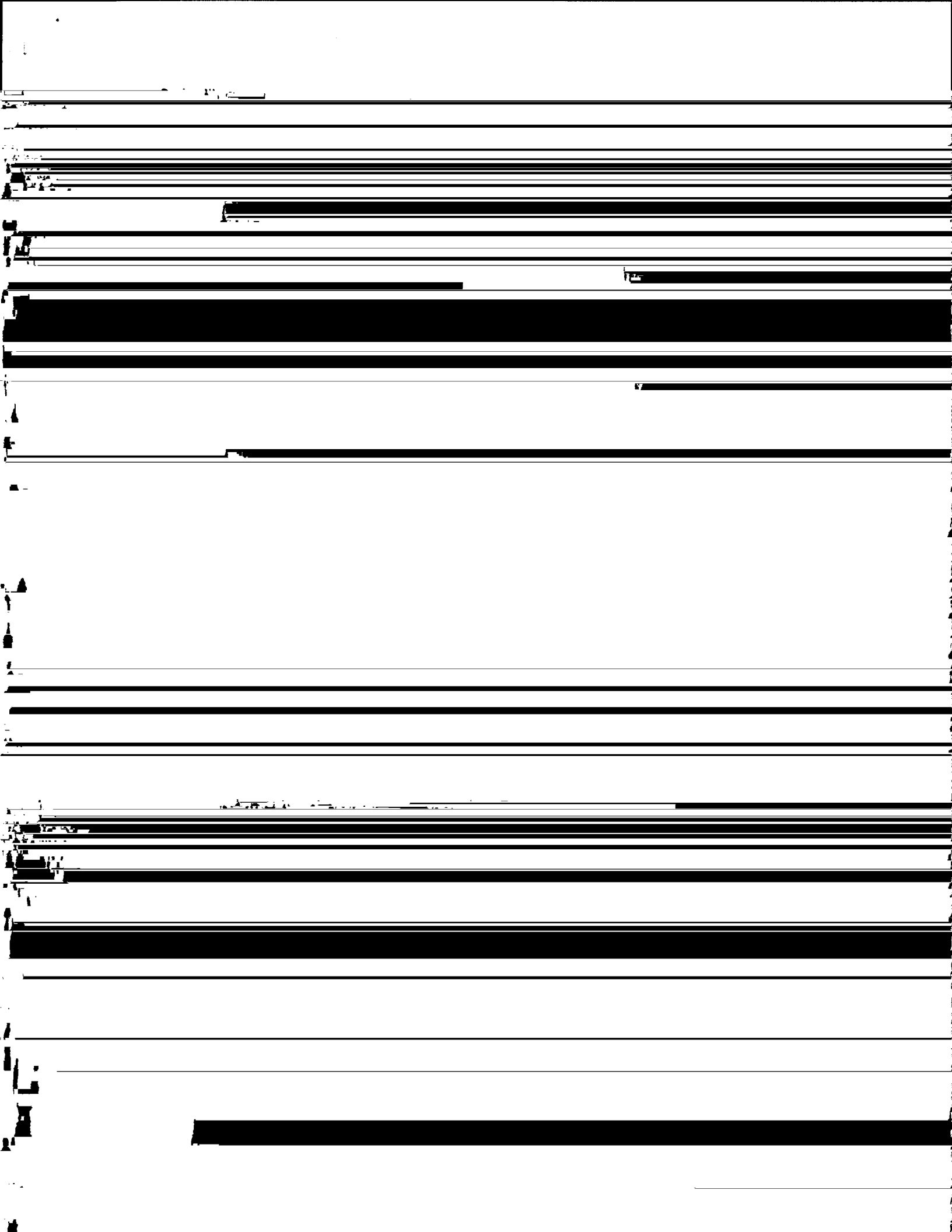
Mr. President,
