The Special Adviser also reiterated her call to all parties to engage seriously in the ongoing efforts aimed at brokering a peaceful resolution to the conflict and protecting the human rights of the Sudanese people. õThe world cannot afford to stand idly by as El Fasher descends into chaos. We must act now to prevent a disaster of unimaginable proportions. I reiterate the call of the Secretary-General for the Parties to return to political dialogue as the only path to a negotiated settlement and to implement resolution 2724 adopted by the Security Council in March 2024.ö" the Special Adviser concluded.
