"Access and participation of women and girls in education, training, science & technology, including girls' empowerment of women's equal access to full employment and decent work"

It is an honor to participate in this session representing the International Network of Liberal Women, which is formed of 44 associations from Asia, the Americas, Africa, Europe and the Middle East.

The activities of the International Network of Liberal Women are inspired by the principles of the Charter of the United Nations and the Universal Declaration of the Human Rights. INLW applies those principles on which the Convention on the Elimination of All Forms of Discrimination Against Women is based.

International Network of Liberal Women's main focus:

- To keep girls in school in environments where she is provided
- Gender-based violence and gender discrimination has to be eliminated.
