Malaysia is a federal constitutional monarchy with a multi-ethnic population. The country is divided into two main regions: Peninsular Malaysia and East Malaysia. The capital is Kuala Lumpur.

The country is a member of the Commonwealth of Nations, the Organisation of Islamic Cooperation, and the Association of South East Asian Nations (ASEAN). It is also a member of the G20 and the BRICS nations.

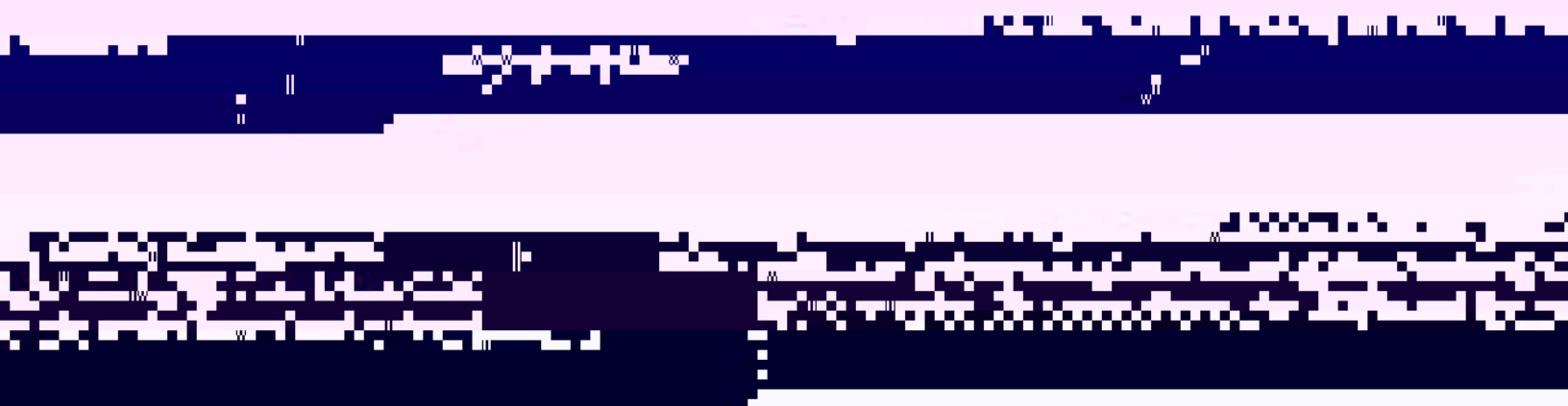
Government

The country is a federal constitutional monarchy. The monarch is the Yang di-Pertuan Agong, who is elected by the Conference of Rulers. The executive power is vested in the Prime Minister and the Cabinet. The legislative power is vested in the Parliament of Malaysia, which consists of the Dewan Rakyat (House of Representatives) and the Dewan Undangan Negeri (State Assemblies).

The judicial power is vested in the Federal Court and the High Courts. The country is a member of the Commonwealth of Nations, the Organisation of Islamic Cooperation, and the Association of South East Asian Nations (ASEAN). It is also a member of the G20 and the BRICS nations.
