Sociological researchers that violence against women and girls is a human rights issue. The research shows that such violence is a form of gender inequality and discrimination, and it is a violation of the rights of women and girls. This research is based on the following findings:

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Bill that seeks to address ‘marital power’ within the marriage regime which often results in conflict manifested in different forms of violence. The bill is also before Parliament for consideration. Other pieces of legislation include the Girls and Women’s Protection Act which seeks to protect women and girls from any form of violence in cognizance of their vulnerability status in society.

Institutional reforms

The Commission’s wide-ranging recommendations include a total overhaul of the Police Force and the Judiciary. The Commission also recommends the creation of a new institution, the National Gender Commission, to coordinate and monitor the implementation of the Commission’s recommendations on gender issues.

comprehensive and effective strategy for the development of a
